'Range of Light' Yosemite Valley Naturalist Tour

Have an incredible day exploring the many wonders of Yosemite National Park while learning about the natural processes that sculpted this landscape and the people who shaped its legacy. This tour is great for all ages and includes visits to scenic vistas, spectacular waterfalls, serene meadows and other renowned Valley attractions.

Giant Sequoia Snowshoe Walk

Enjoy a guided snowshoe walk to an intimate, majestic grove of Giant Sequoias. This 3 mile (round trip) trail, which leads us to the largest tree species on earth, was also one of the original roads into Yosemite Valley and is steeped in history and natural beauty.

Wapama Falls Hike

Come explore Yosemite's hidden secret, the stunning Hetch Hetchy Valley. Our gentle 2.5 mile hike (each way) to 1000-foot Wapama Falls winds above the shores of serene Hetch Hetchy reservoir and provides splendid walking among flowers, creeks and meadows, with memorable views of the reservoir and the domes guarding its shore.

'Owl Prowl'

Experience the best of our 'home' area as we walk through secluded old growth forest in search of the magnificent Great Gray Owl and other forest friends at twilight.
