


Come explore the hidden trails of Yosemite Valley! Our gentle to moderate 4 to 5 mile hike (or snowshoe) winds around many of Yosemite's iconic wonders and provides splendid views of seasonal creeks, meadows, and boulders with memorable views of Yosemite's iconic sights!

This tour showcases the Valley's icons as well as its hidden secrets. You'll gain an understanding of how glaciers, rivers, rocks and erosion created this scenic wonder, and get some insight into John Muir's legacy as our friendly naturalist guides do the driving.



TRIP TIME

9:45AM-3:15PM

GROUP SIZE

2-7 participants. Reservations recommended. Contact Recreation Desk for availability and pricing for groups of 8 or more.

PRICE

\$130 adult; \$70 child (ages 8-12). Includes transportation, naturalist guide, lunch voucher for use in our General Store, and park admission.

DIFFICULTY/AGE LIMIT

Participants should be comfortable walking up to 5 miles on varied terrain at altitudes up to 6,000 feet. Trip is suitable for fit individuals ages 8 and above.

MEETING PLACE

All trips meet at the Recreation Desk 15 minutes before departure.

WHAT TO BRING

- Completed Trip Registration Forms
- Small backpack with at least 32 oz water and snacks
- Proper footwear tennis shoes or hiking boots
- Layered clothing including wind/rain jacket
- Bug repellant, sunscreen, hat and sunglasses
- Camera and binoculars
- In late fall and winter the hiking portion of the trip may be a snowshoeing trip, so be prepared with waterproof boots, warm socks and other warm clothing, including thermal top and bottom, ski hat and gloves

OTHER INFORMATION

Our first-aid-certified guides carry first aid kits, permits, maps, radios/cell phones. Guide gratuity not included; for exemplary service a 10-20% tip is customary.
